Richardson Road and 17th Street Sidewalk Project

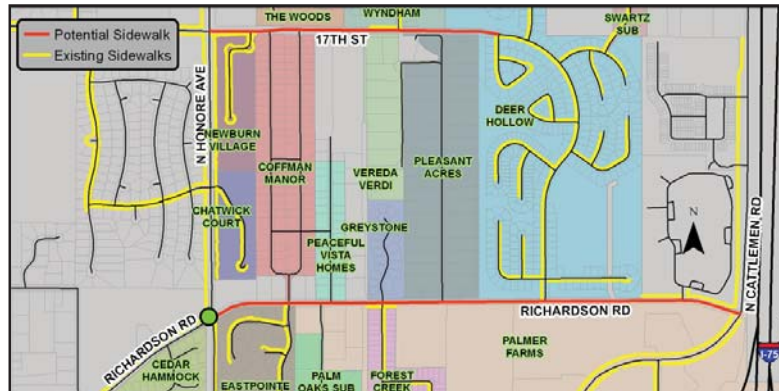

Sarasota County is hosting a public meeting regarding plans for sidewalks in the Fruitville 210 Community and Deer Hollow subdivision area including 17th Street east of Honore Avenue and Richardson Road east of Honore Avenue. There will be a presentation at 5 p.m. followed by an Open House to discuss plans with the engineers and project managers.

The purpose of the meeting is to confirm community support of the previous citizen requests for these segments and to prioritize potential public amenities in that area to be considered for inclusion to the project. Staff will compare the community's priorities with the available funding and project feasibility. That information will be shared again with the community and then prepared for County Commission consideration.



Suggestions for additional amenities

are for roadway lighting on Richardson Road, landscaping or street trees on Richardson Road, possible drainage improvements and extending the Richardson Road sidewalk west to the Cedar Hammock subdivision entrance.

Please also share your thoughts about proposed traffic calming on Richardson Road, west of Cattlemen Road. A pending Rezone petition in the area has led to an offer from the developer to install a traffic table. Greater community input is needed to know whether the traffic calming is desired. Additional area project information will also be available for the Richardson Road/Honore Avenue Roundabout and the construction status of North Cattlemen Road.
